



AMPLEFORTH COLLEGE GOLF CLUB

The course comprises 9 holes through the listed historic park round Gilling Castle, and provides a stimulating challenge for any golfer. It is in a superb setting over undulating terrain with excellent views over the moors and woodland. The course drains well and is never closed for weather conditions (barring snow!). Visitors and new members welcome. The course is in the village of Gilling East on the B1363 from York to Helmsley approximately 18 miles North of York.

The course was constructed in 1960 for the exclusive use of pupils at Ampleforth College. The public golf club was formed in 1972, in co-operation with the College. The Club is affiliated to the Yorkshire and English Golf Unions and has a full programme of matches and competitions. The course is jointly maintained by the Club and Ampleforth Trustees. Ampleforth College pupils have precedence on the course between 2-4p.m. in the school terms.

COURSE DETAILS

9 holes, 5600 yds, SSS 69 (Ladies 5282 yds, SSS 72) Short game practice area and putting green available.

CLUB HOUSE

A new Clubhouse is being constructed with members' clubroom and public changing rooms, toilets and washing facilities. It should be operational by 1st April.

VISITORS

Visitors are most welcome but College pupils have precedence on the course between 2-4 p.m. in the school terms. The course is closed to visitors on some Sunday mornings when competitions are held.
